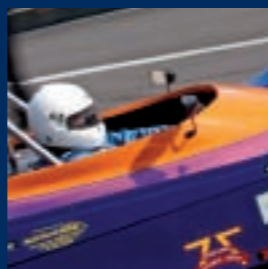

## Announcing the new MARCH 09 Recreation

MARCH Racing Academy is pleased to announce an intention to design, build and sell sports prototype race cars aimed initially for the Sports 2000 Duratec championship. The new recreation race car will be known as MARCH 09/R.
